He never really fitted into a particular music genre and never really felt at home. He can rock, and he isn't a rock singer. Sometimes he sings a simple song, and he isn't simply a singer-songwriter. Ludovique is a vocal phenomenon, a singer with unbelievable spirit and dynamic. From softly intimate to powerfully experimental and with a vocal range that exceeds four octaves.

Older than most when he first dared set foot on stage, he began to write his own material quickly and prolifically. Because he had this strong sense of being an outsider in terms of the conventional scene he kept his work to himself and rarely shared them with others. So, until now, he has been a musical hermit.

This changed a couple of years ago when he had the opportunity to work on his first album with some very inspiring and highly respected musicians like Dominic Miller (Sting, Phil Collins), Manfred Leuchter, Carlo de Wijs, Ferdi Lancee (Gare du Nord) and Michel Bisceglia. That was the moment that he really discovered his own musicality and developed the trust and self-confidence that his work might also be meaningful to the outside world.

The first chance to get to know Ludovique was a remix version of "I Feel Fine (Dreamin')", released in May, 2016. His album "The Naked Singer", which he has produced himself, will show to the world how he has succeeded in expressing his full authenticity while keeping himself firmly 'out of the boxes' that others have created.
